Southwest Florida Community Sports Initiative (SWFL CSI)

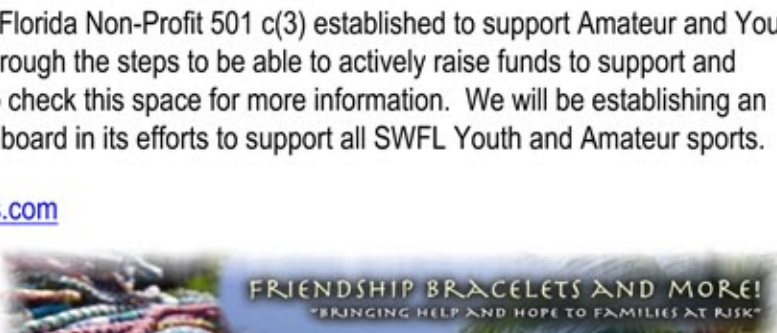
